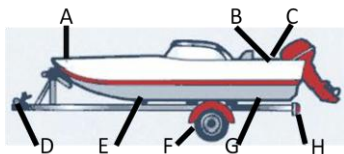


NOTE FROM EFLA PRESIDENT

Remember it is important to remove visible zebra mussels and aquatic plants and drain water before transporting boats and equipment from one water body to another.



Check these areas of your boat:

The buoys have been placed to mark the “no wake” zone in the Edna-Fawn channel. Please adhere to no wake rules.
